## PROPOSED LONG TERM MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR FORMOSA AMENITY GARDEN

I refer to the resolution of Planning Applications Committee no. 3 on 22 March 2016.

The Committee resolved:

That the Committee agrees that the proposed long term management plan for Formosa Amenity Garden is acceptable, including:

- The principle of tree removal and replacement
- The timescale of tree removal and replacement
- The numbers and species of replacement trees and the intended garden design.

Whilst this is not a formal application for consent to remove trees, it is an endorsement of the management plan, in order to provide assurance that future applications for tree removal are unlikely to be refused consent provided the plan is being implemented.
